The library does **not** allow:

- A. Any behavior that is disruptive to library use.
  - B. Sleeping
  - C. Loitering
  - D. Food or uncovered drinks, unless part of a library program.
  - E. Soliciting or selling
  - F. Not wearing shoes and a shirt
  - G. Petitioning/distributing materials
  - H. Leaving children under the age of 7 unattended by a responsible person of at least 13 years of age. (see Unattended Children Policy)
  - I. No use of tobacco products or smokeless devices per the Smoke Free Illinois Act.
  - J. No carrying of any weapon, concealed or partially concealed, in the library building or on library property per Firearm Concealed Carry Illinois Act.

- The library is a public building. Please do not leave your children unattended!
  - Theft or damage of library materials is a serious offense and may lead to arrest.
  - Failure to comply with the library may result in suspension of the library privileges.
  - Trespassers will be prosecuted.
